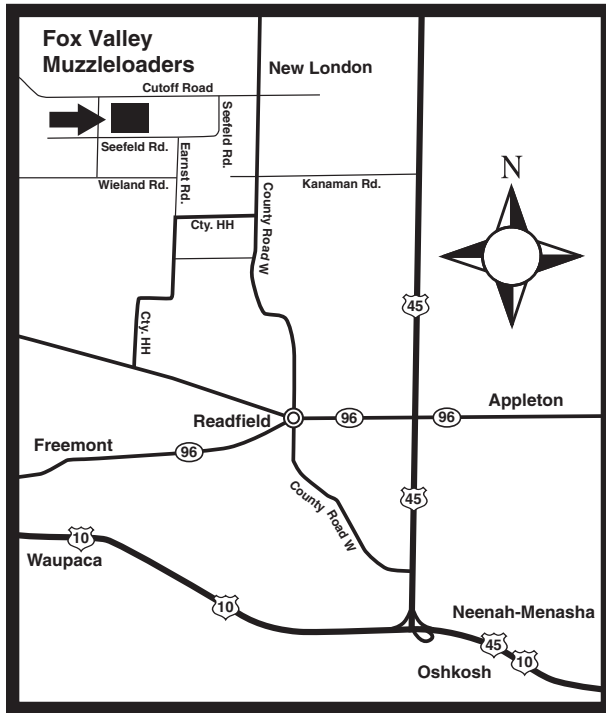

Courses to be offered:

Talking Turkey/Tomahawk Throwing

You'll have the opportunity to learn about the wild turkey and its habits. Learn calling techniques, equipment, camouflage and set-up techniques to improve your chances of seeing and bagging one of these magnificent birds.

Additionally, you will learn the history of tomahawks and have fun learning a new skill by throwing tomahawks at targets—not at each other.



Trailer Handling

This course is for the woman who wants to be independent and confident enough to trailer a boat, ATV, snowmobile, or camper by herself. Learn towing safety, maintenance, and the art of backing up a trailer. A valid driver's license is required.

Self Defense/ Self Protection

If you travel alone, make those late night trips to the store, or are just interested in basic self protection tips, this class is for you! Come and learn basic moves that every woman should know.

Rifle and Shotgun/Black Powder/Muzzleloader Basics

Chainsaw Safety
